

CCCA Chairman's Report on 2025

Thanks to the excellent support of the CCCA committee members we confirmed the decisions I outlined at last years AGM:

The CCCA remains affiliated to the RYA.

I attended the Dinghy Show in Feb 25 and had useful discussions with other small classes, Clubs and representatives of the RYA. The committee remain convinced that currently the costs of having a CCCA stand at the show would not be a good investment of our limited financial resources.

The CCCA continues to communicate with its members through the CCCA Website, e-mail and Facebook. Engagement by members is limited meaning that we get little feedback on the members view of these communications.

The Committee looked at our membership records and concluded that we didn't have up to date data, meaning that we didn't know who our current members were! We have opted to use a small club membership service, Membermojo, which we believe will keep our membership records up to date and safe. This comes at a small cost to the CCCA but, at least for the time being we intend to keep membership of the CCCA free. As of 31 Dec 25, 83 people had signed up to the CCCA via Membermojo, thank you to those that have done so. These are the people we now regard as our members.

Richard Salliss worked very hard to organize the Comet Festival at Cotswold SC which offered racing, cruising and training for all our classes. This together with camping facilities and social events made for a great few days out. Richard is organizing a similar event in 2026 and, as ever, the support of our membership is needed to make it the success it deserves to be.

The Trio Nationals were held at Brixham YC. 7 races were held over 3 days in a variety of conditions. 15 Trios took part, Andrew and Caroline McAusland once again proved their mastery of the Comet Trio to beat off stiff competition and claim their 9th Trio Nationals title.

The Duo World championships was held at Cransley SC. 8 duos attended with Nigel Austin and Matilda Stevenson from Cransley crowned champions after a close battle with Andrew Dale and Amanda Harris from Eyott.
