



Comet Trio Mk1 Inland Championship & Kestrel Open Meeting 2026

NOTICE OF RACE

- (1) The Comet Trio Mk1 Inland Championship and Kestrel Open Meeting will be held at Llangorse Lake, Brecon on Saturday - Sunday, 16 - 17th May 2026. The organising authority is Llangorse Sailing Club.
- (2) Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in The RYA Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028
- (3) Competitors will be honorary members of Llangorse Sailing Club for the duration of the event and by entering, agree to be governed by the Club Rules.
- (4) The Meeting is for Kestrel and Comet Trio Mk 1 classes. (Note Paragraph 2)
- (5) Racing is scheduled as follows: 1 race is required to constitute the series. When fewer than 4 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
When 4 or 5 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst position.

Start times Saturday: Race 1 Kestrels 1300hrs
..... Comet Trios 1305hrs

Races 2 & 3 will be run back-to-back

Start time Sunday: Race 4 Kestrels 1030hrs
... Comet Trios 1035hrs

Race 5 Back- to-back after Race 4

- (6) Competitors will enter by completing an official entry form and paying the fee of £25 per boat and agreeing to the following:
 - ~ 'I agree to be bound by The Racing Rules of Sailing and by all other rules that govern this event'
 - ~ That the race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, howsoever caused to the owner/competitor or crew because of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races.

That the safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the boat.

Registration will commence at 1030 hrs on Saturday 16th May 2026. The Warning signal for the first race will be made not before 1255 hrs

- 7) Sailing Instructions will be available at the time of registration.
- 8) Prizes will be given for the first three places in each fleet.
- 9) Cakes and refreshments will be available after Saturday racing.
There is a planned Evening Meal Event on Saturday evening for Competitors, Supporters and Club members.
Bacon sandwiches will be available Sunday morning before racing.
